


Montreathmont Land Management Plan

Increase level of deer management by increasing level of in-house and external resources.

Develop visitor zone principles in order to enhance visitor experience.

Expand areas of established native broadleaves to enhance habitat networks.

Monitor impact of rabbit population on restock sites.

Clearfell poor Spruce and other species, restock with appropriate species.

FC to implement periodic drains maintenance to ensure water flow and quality is maintained.

On heather dominated sites, consider either pre planting vegetation control or alternative species/nurse species.

Control impact of dothistroma by crown thinning infected coupes as a matter of priority.

Manage Sitka Spruce regeneration as a marketable crop which can be worked as an addition to primary crop.

To control windblow hazard early thinning principles should be applied and coupled with scheduled drain maintenance.

Manage birch regeneration by thinning sizeable stands and recording work in database.

Continue to apply CCF working practise and be receptive to include new areas of candidate CCF into this programme.
