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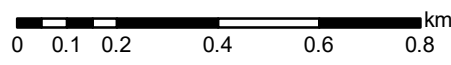

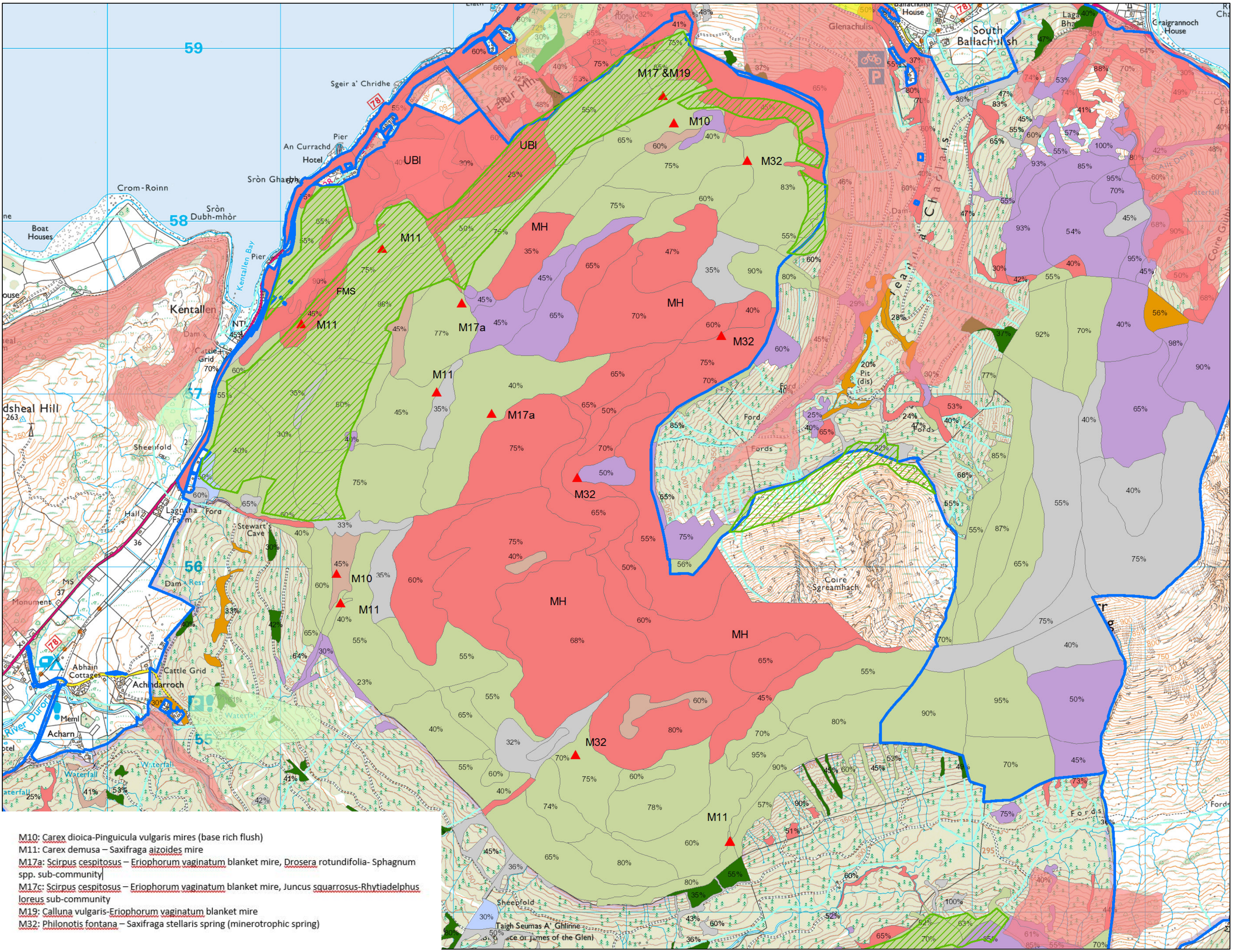

- M11:** *Carex demusa* – *Saxifraga aizoides* mire
- M17a:** *Scirpus cespitosus* – *Eriophorum vaginatum* blanket mire, *Drosera rotundifolia*- *Sphagnum* spp. sub-community
- M17c:** *Scirpus cespitosus* – *Eriophorum vaginatum* blanket mire, *Juncus squarrosus*-*Rhytiadelphus loreus* sub-community
- M19:** *Calluna vulgaris*-*Eriophorum vaginatum* blanket mire
- M32:** *Philonotis fontana* – *Saxifraga stellaris* spring (minerotrophic spring)
