The forests open space component is limited.

Glentauchers distillery sources water from the forest area for both coolant and whisky making.

Broadleaves only make up 1.5% of the forest.

There are a number of water courses which form tributaries leading to the Spey and Isla.

There are soils with medium to high nutrient levels.

A number of coupes are mature and starting to be affected by wind blow.

There is limited access to the south western forest area.

There is a distinct forest/heathland boundary on the upper margins.

There are existing sites within the forest designated as LISS.

There are new acquisition areas lying adjacent and within the forest. These will be done in a separate land management plan.

There are legal commitments in place in regards to the Drummuir wind farm.
