



The A83 is both a strategic transport link to the west & an important tourist route with high visual impacts. Landslips along the un-forested section of the Rest & be thankful have disrupted transport links in the past.

The Cobbler is a very popular destination for walkers with the footpath network and car park at Arrochar facilitating access. Access to the munros Beinn Narnain & Beinn Ime is also dependent on the path network that winds through the forest to the open hill.
