
LISS Map



'Low impact' is defined as the use of silvicultural system where by the forest canopy is maintained at one or more levels without clearfelling. Clearfelling is defined as the cutting-down of all trees on an area of more than 2.0 ha.  
Low Impact Silvicultural System (LISS) implies the use of natural regeneration. All the areas highlighted will be thinned gradually and strategically in order to obtain natural regeneration.
